Principal's Comment:

Our beginning of the year data provides information on specific groups of students that require extra support and those that require extending. At this stage of the year 80% of all our students are on track for achieving curriculum standards in reading, 74% in writing, and 70% in mathematics. Our key target groups are our girls and Maori students. All classes have interventions in place to support their target learners and we have specialist facilitators on board in mathematics, writing and learning with digital technologies. We are on track for high levels of achievement for 2015. We have achieved 93% attendance this term – well done everyone. We will be having an assembly on Thursday to showcase our Multi-coloured Mayhem day for autism awareness. Have a safe and happy Easter break.
