Slices will need to be cut in half for morning tea and lunch. Put out a suitable amount for morning tea for the judges and the rest are for lunch.

Savouries will need to be heated thru they will be thawed.

Please have a person to take bottled water out to judges in the rings (Supplied by the committee). An hour into judging.

Set up Morning Tea and Lunch for Judges and Committee

- Drinks Tea/Coffee/Milo/Sugar/Milk/Bottled Water.
- Boil water for hot Drinks Jugs/Urn set up drinks area.
- FRUIT Chop pineapple and separated grapes
- Plate up catered lunch
- Set out supplied Serviettes/Plastic Cups.
- Heat up Savouries and supply tables as required.
- Collect any rubbish and do any dishes.

Please leave the kitchen as tidy as possible. Your day should be over by approx. 1pm. We will take away the rubbish.
