It is so important to maintain your home learning routines of reading regularly with your child and to continue working on the basic addition facts and times tables. Learning never takes a break!

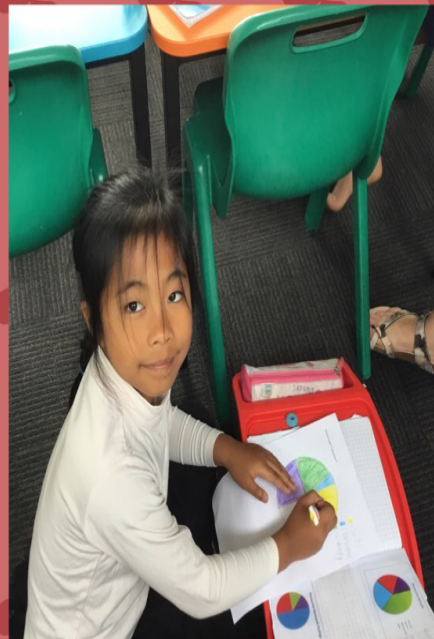
