Alert Level 2 update: We have lift off!

Yesterday it was announced NZ is moving to Level 2 on Thursday. It stated that schools would be open to all students on Monday. We are allowed to transition students back to school starting Thursday. This will be for any parents that are required to go back to work and have no other options for child care. Under Level 2 you can break your family bubble and can ask friends, neighbours & family to care for children on the Thursday & Friday. Please complete the survey coming out today.

Home Learning & Online Sessions

Contact Tracing

The key Public Health approach is to minimise the risk that someone gets infected in the first place, and second to ensure we can identify and contact anyone who has been in close contact with a person, if someone in a school is infected.

Feeling Unwell

Under Alert Level 2, we advise any students and staff to stay at home if they are sick, and we will send anyone home immediately if they show any symptoms.

Drop off Zone

Included is the map to show the traffic flow for dropping off & picking up children. This is for the next 2 weeks.

Our school has safe and sensible practices to maintain the health and safety of everyone on the school site. We will be adopting the recommended practice of regular hand sanitizing. This includes sanitizing all students as they exit & enter classrooms, before & after every break. I will also be at the gate every morning & afternoon, with hand sanitizer, to greet and farewell our students.
